What is this type of insurance?

Genki Explorer is travel health insurance for people who travel multiple months at a time. It covers the cost of medically necessary treatment around the world for a period of up to two years.

🕆 What is insured?

- Medically necessary treatment
- ✓ Any locally recognized healthcare provider
- 24/7 emergency assistance
- Direct billing with any hospital
- ✓ Medical transport to a suitable hospital
- Repatriation to your home country
- Medication & materials

- Emergency dental treatment
- Emergency treatment for mental disorders

- × Pre-existing conditions
- X Dental treatment (except emergencies)
- × Psychotherapy (except emergency inpatient)
- X Consequences of professional sports
- X Consequences of drugs & excessive alcohol
- × Consequences of dangerous activities
- X Consequences of active participation in war

Are there any restrictions on cover?

- If you choose a deductible, then benefits will only be paid in excess of €50 per case.
- If you limit cover in Canada and the USA, then cover there is limited to six weeks per 180 days.
- Cover in your home country is always limited to six weeks per 180 days.
- If you sign up abroad, cover in the first 14 days is limited to accidents and emergencies.
- Pregnancy benefits aren't covered during the first 10 months of insurance.

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Where am I covered?

- You are covered in every country.
- You can choose limited cover in Canada and the USA for a lower premium.
- Cover in your home country is always limited.

What are my obligations?

- Pay the monthly invoice in full and on time.
- File claims as quickly as possible and provide the necessary evidence.
- Release the physician-patient privilege if needed to process a claim.

When and how do I pay?

- The first month will be charged when you sign up for your insurance subscription.
- Recurring monthly charges happen automatically every month on the same day.
- Payments are made with any supported credit or debit card.
- The price of this insurance doesn't change during the subscription.

When does the cover start and end?

- Your cover starts from the date you choose.
- Your subscription and cover end after two years.
- You can cancel your subscription earlier on a monthly basis.
